#### **Application Form**

The mentor artist should fill out, sign, and date Part 1. The apprentice should fill out, sign, and date Part 2.

# **Support Materials**

Provide two letters of support for the mentor artist, and one for the apprentice (three in total). These should be from people who know you well, and who can provide information about your relationship to the tradition you practice.

## **Work Samples**

Include 5-10 images, audio or video clips, or physical objects that exemplify the work of the mentor artist. Provide the same for the work of the apprentice.
